Number of students and classes

65 students will start in your year, 2019, and will be divided into two classes: one Danish and one international, named mmda0919 and mmdi0919 respectively.

The classes will be created as soon as all admitted students have accepted the study place. Afterwards, we will let you know who your new classmates are.

Tutors and Facebook groups for the classes

We have three tutors for each new class. The tutors are students from third semester of Multimedia Design, and they will welcome you when you arrive for study start and initiate different activities with you and your class during beginning of the programme.

The tutors will create closed Facebook groups for each class. We will provide you with the name of the group in August, which will allow you to meet your fellow new students online before study start.

Important materials
